

RLA MOBILE GROUP (GM) 41 SUCCESSFULLY REOCCUPIED THE PROVINCIAL CAPITAL OF SARAVANE ON THE AFTERNOON OF 21 NOVEMBER. GM 41 TROOPS DROVE OUT THE NVA 2D BATTALION, 9TH REGIMENT WHICH HAD HELD THE TOWN SINCE THE 15TH. THE NVA 2D BATTALION SUFFRED 32 CASUALTIES IN THE ACTION, WHILE RLA LOSSES HAD NOT YET BEEN REPORTED. IN TWO EARLIER CLASHES ON 20 NOVEMBER, RLA GM 41 AND 42 ELEMENTS ATTEMPTING TO RETAKE SARAVANE REPORTED THEIR LOSSES AS ONE MAM KILLED.AND 11 HOUNDED, WHILE NVA CASUALTES IN THE ACTION, WHILE RLA LOSSES HAD NOT YET BEEN REPORTED. IN TWO EARLIER CLASHES ON 20 NOVEMBER, RLA GM 41 AND 42 ELEMENTS ATTEMPTING TO RETAKE SARAVANE PROVINCES ON 21 NOVEMBER, ACCORDING TO THE REPORT, HE 9TH REGIMENT, NVA 968TH DIVISION, REPORTED ON THE LOCATION OF RLA UNITS OPERATING IN SEDONE-SARAVANE PROVINCES ON 21 NOVEMBER. ACCORDING TO THE REPORT, THERE IS ONE \$ENEMY\$ UNIT AT HB 88825 (15-12N 185-54E). AS A RESUL, NVA FORCES WERE TO BE SENT TO GUARD AGAINST THIS \$ENEMY\$ OROUP. IT WAS FURTHER REPORTED THAT RLA COMMANDO BATTALION 203 IS CONTINUING ACTIVITY NORTHEAST OF AN UNSPECIFIED STRATEGIC ROUTE. THE REGIMENT ALSO REVEALED THAT RLA MOBILE GROUP 481 ARRIVED AT THE LAONGAM (XB 8576 15-18N 185-59E). INTERSECTION AND THAT RLA COMMANDO BATTALION 233 IS CONTINUING ACTIVITY NORTHEAST OF AN UNSPECIFIED STRATEGIC ROUTE. ELEMENTS OF NORTH VIETNAMESE 234TH AND 275TH SAM REGIMENTS DEPLOY SOUTHWARD ON 18 NOVEMBER, AN ADVANCE ELEMENT OF THE 234TH SAM REGIMENT CROSSED THE LINH CAM FERRY (WF 6048, 18-31N 105-34E) IN HA TINH PROVINCE. IN ADDITION, VEHICLES BELONGING TO POSSIBLY THE 67TH SAM BATTALION AND THE 70TH TECHNICAL SUPPORT BATTALION OF THE 275TH SAM REGIMENT WERE REPORTEDLY TRANSPORTED ACROSS. SINCE AS EARLY AS 6 OCTOBER, AIR DEFENSE UNITS IN SOUTHERN NORTH VIETNAM HAVE MADE REFERENCE TO ELEMENTS OF THE 234TH REGIMENT. XXHH 900 #8968 NNNN
