TRACK 28 (2 SMALL TYPES AT 4,888 METERS) ONLY NOTED AT 1681 AT 28-45N 184-43E II. SAM REACTION (FIRST WAVE) FROM 1188Z TO 1459Z, SIX NVN SAM BATTALIONS WERE NOTED IN REACTION TO U.S. AIR STRIKES IN THE HANOI AREA. A MINIMUM OF THIRTEEN MISSILES WERE LAUNCHED RESULTING IN THE LOSS OF ONE B-52 (CHARCOAL Ø3) AND SEVERE DAMAGE TO ANOTHER (LILAC) WHICH RECOVERED AT UTAPAO, THAILAND ((1)). TWO OF THE REACTING UNITS ARE SUBORDINATE TO THE 267TH SAM REGIMENT AND ARE DEPLOYED IN THE GENERAL THANH HOA AREA. ONE OF THE REACTING UNITS, SUBORDINATE TO THE 264TH SAM REGIMENT IS DEPLOYED IN THE HANDI AREA. ONE UNIT, POSSIBLY ASSOCIATED WITH/THE 272ND SAM REGIMENT, IS DEPLOYED IN THE HANDI AREA, AND TWO OTHER U/I BATTALIONS ARE DEPLOYED IN THE GENERAL HAIPHONG AREA. BETWEEN 1328Z AND 1344Z A MESSAGE FROM AN UNIDENTIFIED NVN AIR OPERATIONS STATION REPORTED THAT SOME AIRCRAFT WAS BURNING AND FALLING. BURNING RAPIDLY. DON'T KNOW IF IT WAS ONE OF OURS OR ONE OF HIS.\$ POST-LAUNCH CONVERSATIONS BETWEEN 1334Z AND 1337Z/ INDICATE THAT BATTALIONS 51 AND 52 OF THE 267TH SAM REGIMENT, POSSIBLY LOCATED/IN THE VICINITY OF 19-18N 105-28E OR 28-14N 185-51E (VN558), APPARENTLY LAUNCHED THO MISSILES EACH AT THE SAME B-52 AT 1317Z. THREE OF THE MISSILES EXPLODED WELL IN PROXIMITY TO THE TARGET. ONE OF THE MISSILES LAUNCHED BY BATTALION 52 WAS SLOW TO DETONATE AND WENT PAST THE TARGET PRIOR TO DETONATION. BETWEEN 1537ZAND 1540Z, TWO UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKERS. POSSIBLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE 234TH SAM REGIMENT (HANDI AREA), DISCUSSED PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED \$ IN THE MORNING\$ FOR REPORTING \$THE WEAKNESSES AND IMPROVEMENTS IN THE BATTLE SITUATION THAT JUST PASSED. SO ONE OF THE SPEAKERS THEN REPORTED THAT ONE PILOT WAS CAPTURED NEAR AN UNIDENTIFIED UNIT. NEITHER THE PILOT'S IDENTITY NOR THE TYPE AIRCRAFT SHOT DOWN WAS DISCLOSED. LATER, BETWEEN 1629Z AND 1640Z, BATTALION 76 OF THE 264TH SAM REGIMENT, DEPLOYED JUST TO THE WEST OF HANOI, REPORTED THE LAUNCH OF THREE MISSILES AT TWO B-52S. A TWO-MISSILE SALVO WAS LAUNCHED AT 1254Z AND A SINGLE MISSILE AT 1322Z THE ACTUAL DOWNING OF THE INTENDED TARGET(S) WAS NOT DISCLOSED((1)). BETWEEN 1803Z AND 1833Z, BATTALION 59 OF THE PROBABLE 272ND SAM REGIMENT (UNLOCATED, HANDI AREA), REPORTED LAUNCHING FOUR MISSILES AT UNIDENTIED HOSTILE AIRCRAFT, TWO AT 1305Z AND TWO AT 1315Z. THE FIRST TWO MISSILES REPORTED DISHOT THE AIRCRAFT DOWN \$IN A BALL OF FLAMESS. IN SUMMING UP THE SECOND LAUNCH, THE SPEAKER REPORTED THAT AFTER THE FIRST MISSILE DETONATED JAMMING DISAPPEARED AND THE TARGET WAS OBSERVED TO HAVE BURST INTO A LARGE BALL OF FLAMES. BATTALION 57, OF ALSO THE PROBABLE 272ND/REGIMENT REPORTEDLY OBSERVED THAT TARGET HIT THE GROUND IN A LARGE BALL OF FLAME IN A LATER MESSAGE, AN UNIDENTIFIED SAM UNIT REPORTED (THAT,) SAT 1300Z, [WE] SHOT DOWN ONE B-52 AT THON KIM ANH (21-13N 105-45E) WHICH IS NEAR PHU LO (21-12N 105-51E). [ACCORDING TO THE PRELIMINARY REPORT] THERE WERE FIVE PIRATE PILOTS. TWO ARE DEAD AND WE WERE ABLE TO CAPTURE THREE OF
