THE HELICOPTER LANDED FORTY PEOPLE IN THE VICINITY OF OUR MED FRIENDS AT ((HP)) 1800 ((3)). THE UNITS OF MR. CUONG ((4)) ARE LEARNING THE TECHNIQUES OF SHOOTING AIRCRAFT AND THE TACTICS OF ATTACK. STILL, THE UNITS OF MR. CHIEU ((4)) ((CHIEU)) HAVE TRENCHES AND THE FIREPOWER TO CONCENTRATE ON STUDYING THE SHOOTING OF WEAPONS. YOU SHOULD BE READY TO FIRE A 12.7 MM ((WEAPON)) WHEN A AIRCRAFT FLIES OVER IN ORDER TO SHOOT IT DOWN. OUR FRIENDS REPORT THAT THE AIRCRAFT WAS DOWNED AND WE CAPTURED SEVEN PERSONS, ONE AMERICAN MAJOR WHO WAS THE PILOT AND SIX MED'S. THE NINE B52'S STRUCK NEAR THE TRI-BORDER AREA TODAY. THEY CAUSED MANY PROBLEMS.
