IN REGARDS TO THE SITUATION IN THAILAND, COMPANY 4 REPORTED THAT THE PATHET LAO HAD ASSISSED THE SITUATION AND REPORTED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON 24, 25 AND 27 OCTOBER. AT BAN BUNG KHLA, THAILAND (1817N 18488E UF9422) THERE ARE THREE COMPANIES WHICH HAVE FIVE 68/82MM MORTARS, AT BAN NONG DOEN THA, THAILAND (1819N 18358E UF9126) WHICH IS WEST OF BAN PAK KADING. THESE ARE TWO COMPANIES WHICH HAVE THREE 82MM MORTARS, AND AT BAN DOEN THAILAND (1818N 18358E UF9124) WHICH FACES BAN PAK KADING, THERE IS AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF COMPANIES ARMED HITH THO 82MM MORTARS, M79
