TO THE HORTH, IT MAS REPORTED ON & DECEMBER THAT AN ESTIMATED TWO PAVE BATTALIONS HAD MOVED WEST FROM SAM HEUA TO THE AREA OF UN 6868 (20-31H 183-44E). THE EREMY PROPAGAMDIZED THAT THEY INTEND TO ATTACK RLA GUERRILLA FORCES IN THE AREA EITHER DURING DECEMBER OR IN JAMUARY 1968. IN OTHER DEVELOPMENTS, AN F-185 REPORTEDLY CRASHED ON 5 DECEMBER HEAR ROUTE 6 AT UN 9234 (20-12H 183-58E). THE FATE OF THE PILOT IS UNKNOWN. SOUTH LAOS MILITARY REGION

PATHET LAO (PL) COMPANY ATTACKED AN RIA BATTALION AT HOME SA. FAR TO THE HORTH, IN PHONE SALY PROVINCE, A U.S. HELT- COPTER WAS SHOT DOWN IN LATE HOVEMBER KILLING THE PILOT M. BURKE, ACCORDING TO AN 8 DECEMBER DISSIDENT HEUTPALIST (I.E., GEN KHAMMOUANE) MESSAGE. THE FATE OF THE THO OTHER CRESS MEMBERS IS AS YET UNDISCLOSED. MILITARY REGION 2 COMMUNIST ACTIVITY SOUTHWEST OF SAM MEMA CONTINUES TO BE HEAVY. ON 6 DECEMBER, PHA LOWAM (20-62N 163-58E, UN 9216) FELL TO THO ENEMY BATTALIONS AND A THIRD BATTALION ATTACKED BAN CHONG (20-62N

3 REPORTS OF ENEMY INTENTIONS TO ATTACK RLA POSITIONS AND A CONTINUING HIGH VOLUME OF ENEMY TRUCK TRAFFIC IN THE TCHEPONE AREA HIGHLIGHTED HR 3 ACTIVITY THIS PAST NEEK. OH 11 DECEMBER TACTICAL COMMAND SOUTH LAOS REPORTED THAT THE EHEMY HAS INCREASED "REQUISITION ACTIVITY" IN THE MAHAXAY AND MHOWWARATH AREAS WHICH REPORTEDLY "INDICATES THE PROBABILITY OF SYNCHROHIZED ATTACKS ON THE 35TH, 36TH, 37TH VOLUNTEER BATTALIONS AND THE 18TH NOBILE GROUP (GN)." ANOTHER REPORT DISCLOSED THAT ENEMY TROOPS INTENDED TO LAUNCH ATTACKS ON RLA POSITIONS IN THE SE BANG FAI (RIVER) AND SALA NA DENG AREAS IN CENTRAL MR 3. REPORTED COMMUNIST TRUCK TRAFFIC INCLUDED THE MOVEMENT ON 5 DECEMBER OF 24 TRUCKS FROM TCHEPONE ALONG ROUTE 9 TO MUONG PHINE (16-30N 106-02E, XD 1029) WHILE 12 TRUCKS RE- TURNED TO TCHEPONE FROM MUONG-MITNE AND ON 8 DECEMBER, 24 MORE TRUCKS REPORTEDLY ALSO TRAVELED ALONG ROUTE 9 TO-TCHEPONE FROM BAN DONG (16-37H 106-25E, XD 5238), LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 10 KM HEST OF THE LAGTIAN-SOUTH VIETNAMESE BORDER. IN BOTH INSTANCES THE CARGO WAS UNDISCLOSED. MILITARY REGION 4 HEADQUARTERS MR 4 HAS DESCRIBED THE SITUATION IN THE REGION AS "VERY CRITICAL." THE NEUTRALIST GM 804 COMMAND POST WAS BURNED DURING AN ATTACK LAUNCHED BY ENEMY FORCES ON 11 DECEMBER IN WHICH LAO NGAM (15-28H 196-19E, XC 2610) RE- PORTEDLY FELL BUT WAS RECAPTURED BY RLA AND HEUTRALIST FORCES ON THE FOLLOWING DAY. IT HAD BEEN REPORTED SEVERAL DAYS EARLIER THAT A LARGE FORCE OF "CHINESE" TROOPS WOULD ARRIVE APPROXIMATELY 17 KM NORTH OF LAD NGAM ON AN UNSPECIFIED DATE. MOREOVER, ACCORDING TO AN RLA REPORT ON 13 DECEMBER, A CONVOY OF 128 TRUCKS (CARGO UNKNOWN) HAS ARRIVED AT XC 9415-(15-38H 186-48E), EAST OF BAN PHONE ON ROUTE 16. (3/0/517/R299-67. R291-67. R292-67.
