## Report on Indian Bureau Messages.

A total of 27 code messages, together with a code book (Telegraph and Cable Code of the Department of the Interior, Serial No. 1490) were turned over to the undersigned by Mr. Tatrow, representing Mr. Louis R. Glavis, Chief Investigator for the Senate Committee on Indian Affairs. Mr. Tatrow stated that efforts to decode these messages by the code mentioned, which was furnished for this purpose upon request of the Committee, had been without result, although other code messages had been decoded by him by means of this code. The problem presented was, therefore, to obtain a translation of these messages either with or without the use of the code furnished.

A careful examination of the code book soon showed that it was obviously not the one that had been employed to encode these messages, or, if it had been, special secret instructions had been used, and the latter not furnished. Work was therefore at once initiated to break down the messages by cryptanalytic methods, with the results attached hereto, as Annex 1.

These messages consist of mixtures of code, cipher, and plain text. The cipher groups were deciphered by means of the following deciphering alphabet, reconstructed by frequency analysis:

The code groups were decoded by the usual cryptanalytic processes of solving parallel code group-plain language progressions. The

skeleton code resulting therefrom is attached as Annex 2.

It may be said that so far as the decipherment of the cipher portions is concerned, the work is 100% valid, and so far as the decoding of the code portions is concerned, approximately 90 to 95% valid. Here and there a synonymous word may be substituted for the real word itself, and there remain a very few words the meanings of which have not been determined because it is impossible to corroborate any assumption for their value, due to the paucity of the material available for study.

It seems obvious that the code book employed to prepare these messages is not the one furnished the Committee, since the external and internal constitution of the messages and the construction of the code words, as well as of the cipher alphabet, bear no resemblances to those which would result from the actual use of the code book furnished, if the latter had been employed in accordance with printed instructions contained therein.
