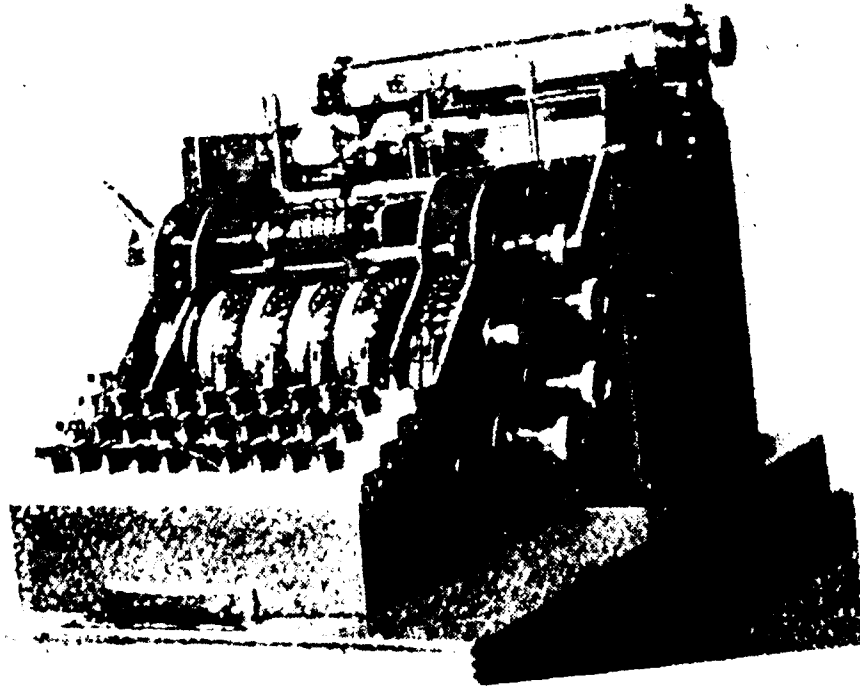


Abb. 2. Chiffriermaschine ohne Verschlus-  
kappen.

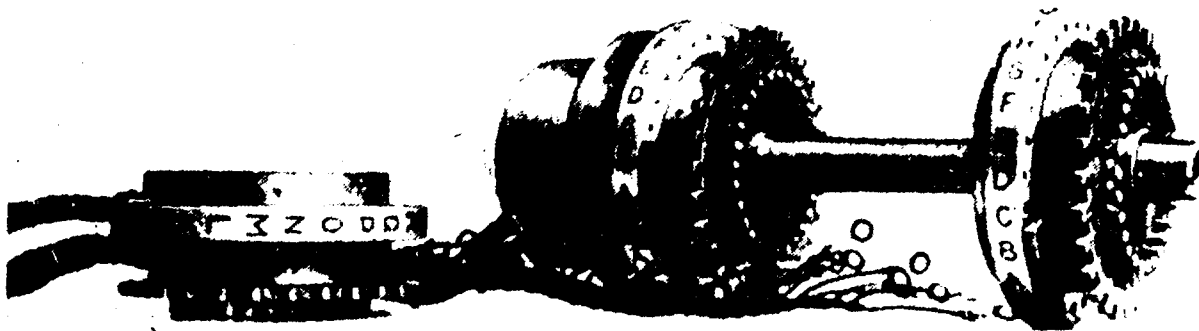


Abb. 3. Papierwalzen der Chiffriermaschine.

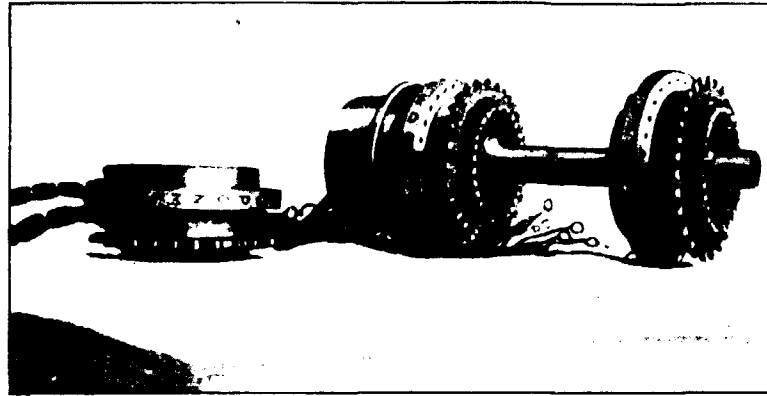

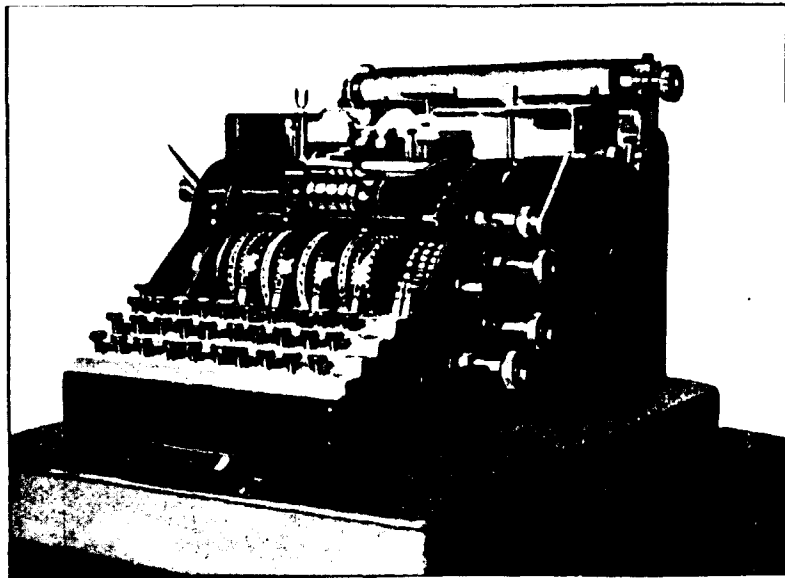

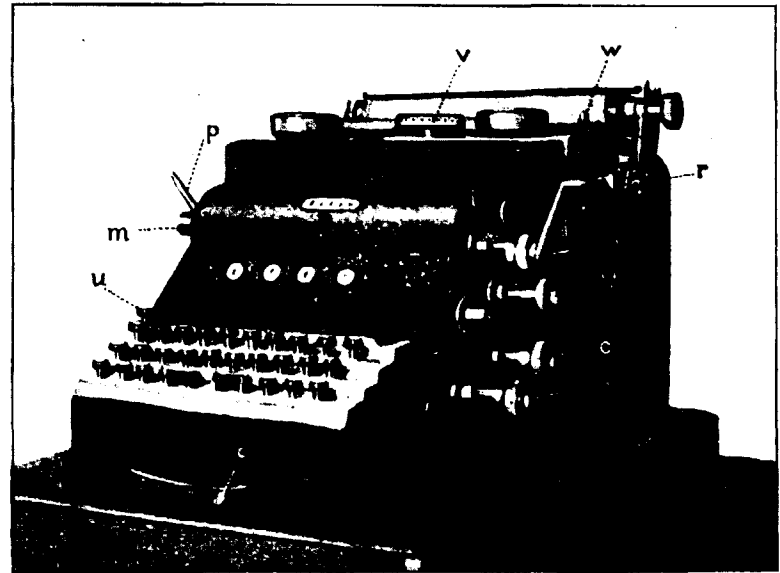
