On learning in a personal talk with Lt Col Colton that there were those who thought I had strenuously objected to making an assignment of this patent & that certain misrepresentations had been made (not by me, he admitted) regarding how long a patent application could be held up in Pat Off, I told Col Colton I'd make the assignment at the very first moment it was presented for execution, & that I personally had never objected to assigning an invention the C Sig O wanted to keep secret.
