MEMORANDUM FOR: Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2.

It is recommended that a radio reply substantially as follows be made to the Commanding General, Hawaiian Department:

"No codes other than diplomatic are available in reply your twelve sixty four stop Such diplomatic as now being intercepted believed to be of no value to you stop Navy traffic is of most value to Hawaiian Department stop Cryptanalytic section now in operation at Pearl Harbor under CINCUS stop Your cooperation with this unit is recommended and has been requested by Navy Department stop You are authorized to make local arrangement for collaboration additional personnel to be furnished you upon advice as to number needed stop Army codes will be furnished you immediately they become available through solution or capture."
