A. UNIDENTIFIED INFILTRATION/TRAINING HEADQUARTERS , POSSIBLY ATTAINS OPERATIONAL STATUS

ON 16 FEBRUARY 1966, A MESSAGE ENCIPHERED IN THE CRYPTOSYSTEM PECULIAR TO PAVN ELEMENTS DEPLOYED OR DEPLOYING OUT-OF-COUNTRY WAS OBSERVED. THIS MESSAGE WAS PASSED VIA THE QUOTE WATCH UNQUOTE LINK BETWEEN HEADQUARTERS MILITARY REGION FOUR, VINH AND THE UNIDENTIFIED INFILTRATION/TRAINING HEADQUARTERS LOCATED IN THE VINH AREA.

THIS WAS THE FIRST AND ONLY APPEARANCE OF THIS CRYPTOSYSTEM BEING UTILIZED BETWEEN THESE TWO HEADQUARTERS AND SUGGEST A POSSIBLE DEPLOYMENT OF THIS DRY FNTITY.

18. POSSIBLE SHOOTDOWN OF U.S. AIRCRAFT

ON THE TERMANDAL 1966, AN UNIDENTIFIED SUBGROINATE REPORTED TO HEADQUARTERS MILITARY REGION (ROMAN) THREE THAT A SORTIE OF AIRCRAFT HAD BEEN SPOTTED AT 8688 ZULU. THE MESSAGE INDICATED FURTHER THA FZZG LSDFREARY TRANSPORT

BEEN SHOT DOWN AND THAT THE PROPRIATE BEAD

ON 28 FEBRUARY 1964. MAI KHANH MAU, COMMANDER OF THE MOC CHAU DISTRICT UNIT SENT A MESSAGE TO THE SUN LA PROVINCIAL UNIT COMMAND SECTION STATING THAT A U.S. A6A L RCRAFT HAD BEEN SHOT DOWN AT TU NANG VILLAGE (17) 94181 (28 58N 184 26E)). THE PILOT AND CREW MEMBERS WERE REPORTED KILLED.
